

## THREADING A NEEDLE



## SUPPLIES:

- Hand Sewing Needle
- ☐ Spool of Thread
- ☐ Scissors

## PROCEDURES:

- 1. READ ALL DIRECTIONS FIRST!!
- 2. Cut ONE piece of thread (about the length of your arm from fist to elbow) off the spool of thread.
- 3. Cut the end of the thread at a slant.
- 4. Hold the needle, with your fingers in the middle of the needle & the eye at the top.
- 5. Hold the thread, close to the end that you cut at a slant.
- 6. Bring the NEEDLE and THREAD together at the eye of the needle.
- 7. Gently push the thread, just enough to grab from the other side, through the eye of the needle.
- 8. Pull 1/2 of the remaining thread through the eye of the needle.
